I am writing to express my concern about the proposed development of new houses in Lymm due to the lack of high school places in Lymm High.

At the time we moved there were some spaces in the high school for children not in feeder schools. We decided not to change our children's primary schools as they were doing well and settled. We made the assumption that we could apply (and expect to get) a School place in Lymm High due to our proximity to the School. This year we have been told (by Warrington admissions team) probably won't get a place, as for the last two years no children who were not in feeder schools got a place.

As there are not enough places now where will people moving in to new houses with older children have to send them to school? It is ridiculous to say what Lymm needs is more leisure facilities!!! We need more school places for local children. It is ridiculous that Lymm High takes children living miles away because they were sent to a feeder school.
