The stranded vehicle caused traffic problems and also possible damage to the bridge as I'm sure it was well over the weight limit for such a small canal bridge.

I assumed that the lorry was heading for the building development behind Sainsbury's on Rushgreen Road.

I think that this photograph illustrates very well some of the problems that Lymm is likely to encounter in the future when more housing is squeezed into a village which simply does not have the infrastructure or road network to cope with the added housing planned for South Warrington.

Surely, a modicum of common sense is required from town planners to realise that too much new housing in this area is simply not practical.
