As a longstanding resident of the town [REDACTED] the council I had thought it had the towns' best interests at heart. I was very much mistaken.

Whilst we understand the need for more houses, how it can be justified to build so many on green belt (and barely anything in the north of the town) I can not comprehend. Also whilst removing services and not appearing to add any infrastructure and basic needs the area would require makes no sense.

The A49 is already extremely busy. If there's an incident on the motorway, as happened on Thursday, this only adds to the issues. What the pollution levels must already be like I dread to think. This would only worsen. In a time when we are all supposed to be doing more for the environment this is going against everything. Basic things like parking, particularly in Stockton Heath, already appears to be at capacity. What is going to happen here?

Centres for babies have already been closed, I've been told now my only local drop in health clinic for any concerns is at Lymm.....

My questions:

What is going to be done about the extra cars on the roads? Traffic, pollution, new roads - any plans?

Schools- new ones would be needed, where?

Shops, there's already nothing in Appleton Thorn. These would require access and parking. Stockton Heath clearly couldn't cope.

Doctors- existing surgeries are already extremely busy. New ones would be required. Again needing access and parking.

How this idea can be a sound idea I am completely dumbfounded. Please rethink these considerations seriously otherwise there will be many unhappy residents in what is now a beautiful place to live.
