Regarding the above plan to build houses on Thelwall Heys, I believe that in 2004 this was designated as Special Landscape Character Status and as far as I can see, Nothing has Changed.

It was also given greenbelt status which was defended by WBC in 2006 when developers wanted to overturn it. Nothing has changed.

Thelwall Heys is enclosed by the Trans Pennine trail and the Bridgewater Canal and is a haven for wildlife and also for people who use both of these paths for exercise and quiet reflection, which is invaluable for mental and physical well being, never more so than in the last 18 months and the peace and tranquility would be lost by the building of houses on the site.

Lastly, but certainly not of less importance is already the lack of health services in this area, more GP surgeries are needed and also people are having to wait hours, in pain, for an ambulance.

There are already numerous houses being built in nearby Grappenhall and Appleton and this will only make the situation a whole lot worse.
