I am a local resident of Appleton and having looked at the local plan, don't feel that the original concerns of local residents have been addressed.

In the main -

Many houses being built on existing greenbelt unnecessarily - removing wildlife habitat that is so desperately needed.

The plan exceeds the forecast for required housing

Infrastructure has not been detailed in particular doctors and dentists. My husband has been unable to find an NHS dentist locally and has not been able to join the nearest Dr's as they are so heavily over subscribed. More houses without allocation and provision of these services in South Warrington is short sighted and leaves local residents struggling.

The level of congestion in South Warrington is already frustrating and affects air quality. Living [REDACTED] I cannot leave my drive at certain times of the day due to the traffic. Putting more pressure on the road network with in excess of 4000 more homes is unsustainable.

I strongly object to the proposals in particular to South Warrington as the area just cannot handle up to another 8000 cars on these roads (there aren't many households these days that don't have 2 cars...) and hope that this objection be heard appropriately.
