Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to object to the proposed local plan.

I do not feel that the infrastructure required to support such a plan has been adequately addressed or communicated.

The areas for which employment has been designated do not align with the local community. There are enough low-paid roles already. Adding more isn't benefitting the community; it's just encouraging people to travel from other areas for these roles. Our roads are already heavily congested with traffic, and I can see how this is actually being resolved prior to adding yet more traffic.

The extra traffic will only contribute to the existing air quality issues, which is a real worry for everyone. With the current climate change crisis, it feels wrong.

How will education be addressed? Local schools are already pretty full, and most are in heavily congested areas during peak traffic.

The lack of clarity in the plan, along with reliance on developer money for facilities, feels badly managed. If we do indeed build these houses, the plan should set out exactly what the impact is and how this is being addressed, rather than relying on a kind of organic development.

I feel there is little justification for the large-scale development of green belt when we already have huge amounts of brownfield sites. It feels like we are giving developers an easy ride and huge profits, while the community and ultimately the Borough will not benefit in the long run.
