I'd like the plan to be reviewed, please. There seems to be a failure (1) to establish sufficient infrastructure and a failure (2) to link jobs and houses.

There seems to be an ambition to build houses only. There's no sign of infrastructure or services. And so existing routes, businesses and services will be overwhelmed.

Forty years ago two miles of houses were put up in Appleton from the top of Bridge Lane out towards Stretton. The only complimentary extras were two post boxes (one of which was brick-built and didn't look at all like a post box) and an hourly bus that stopped at 6 pm so that you could go to work but not get back!

As a result Stockton Heath village has become a bottleneck and the Causeway is a no-go area except in the dead of night.

To put up more housing in Appleton without infrastructure will further clog our roads and devalue the business centre of Stockton Heath.

As you look from the heights of Appleton across the town you see the mushrooming of warehousing along the M62. Why are we creating jobs in North Warrington and aiming to build homes in south Warrington? Should we not be considering our carbon footprint and aiming to return to the days when you lived above the shop, sort of thing, to cut out rush hour emissions as much as possible?
