Sir or Madam.

I strongly object to the current Local Plan being proposed by the Council for the South East Extension and any extra proposals, the use of green belt land for any development is hardly a sustainable or green in any way shape or form and also the county can't afford the loss of important agricultural land with the ongoing Brexit and Covid situation making food security very important, the environmental impact would be catastrophic with the loss of important habitats for wildlife and important green spaces for people to enjoy.

It is apparent that green belt land is considered a soft target while using brownfield sites should be a mandatory requirement and also green belt land should have absolute protection over all development proposals.
