Your latest attempt to provide a coherent plan for the development of South Warrington is no more persuasive than the previous one, for the following reasons:

- 1) no justification provided for the numbers of new houses envisaged, which exceeds the need, and with only 30% "affordable" housing, is simply a licence for developers to print money.
- 2) no detailed planning of infrastructure, especially routes into Warrington and canal crossings; the likely outcome will be even more traffic congestion and gridlock. Increasing public transport without the infrastructure would be futile.
