We strongly object to the proposal regarding the development known as Six56 close to Junction 20 of the M6 motorway.

We live at **a seen the volume of traffic** from Lymm trying to access the motorways drastically increase over the past few years causing long queues backing down Cherry Lane.

The roundabout cannot accommodate the amount of HGV's leaving the motorway to either use the services, or proceed towards Stretton and is frequently gridlocked .

Add to this the occasional breakdown or accident on the Thelwall Viaduct closing the northbound carriageway of the M6 and the whole of Lymm, Thelwall, Grappenhall and parts of Warrington come to a dead stop for hours.

How would it be possible to bring even more HGV's onto this junction to enter the proposed warehousing facility? It cannot work.

We also suffer from one of the highest levels of air pollution in Warrington, this development would only increase this.

If this area of greenbelt is designated for employment, then I agree with Lymm Parish Council that it would be more fitting as a science hub than a logistics facility, creating jobs not traffic jams and pollution.
