My comments on the proposed revised Local Plan:-

- 1) I object to the use of green belt land in The Plan. With the worries about the effects of climate change, every effort should be made to keep the green belt to prevent a further deterioration of air quality for the residents of South Warrington.
- 2) The government has recently proposed that brown field sites should be used in order to preserve the greenbelt and prevent urban sprawl. Warrington has brown field sites which should be used before use of the green belt is even considered.
- 3) In South Warrington thousands of houses have already been built in or are in the course of construction. There have been no improvements to the roads to prevent gridlocked traffic. Standing traffic adds to air quality problems. Greenhouse gases need to be reduced.
- 4) The medical facilities in the area are already over-stretched.
- 5) There are no facilities for teenagers.
- 6) The proposed Six56 employment area at Lymm would use the greenbelt and cause further problems on the M6 and M56 - motorways already congested and with frequent accidents which cause problems in Warrington when traffic is trying to find alternative ways of passing through Warrington.

The Local Plan should be reconsidered, starting at a point where brown-field sites should be used before green belt is specified. The continued development of the surrounding local villages should be stopped before their character is even further destroyed.
