I object to several aspects of the current draft:-  
Congestion. There are rarely any times in Stockton Heath when the village (London Road) is not badly congested. 4,200 houses and a large area for industry will create unhealthy air pollution, (Stockton Heath's P.Cl. can demonstrate that some particulates are already approaching WHO's maximum.) gridlock and destruction of the greenbelt. Developers MUST be made to respect the need for community facilities eg. schools, medical centre, leisure and to incorporate them as conditions of planning permission.

There is only brief mention of new recycling facilities.

The housing figure is much higher than the 2018 forecasts.

The green belt is more essential than ever if we are going to 'green' our environment. (COP 26)

I speak as a resident of Stockton Heath and a former Borough Councillor and current Parish Councillor. There are many other issues.
