Why I believe the local plan is not sound:-

Already the road networks in Warrington can not cope. The new road built from Chester road to Bank Quay has queues on it and once the land at the Chester Road end is developed this road will be at a standstill. This is just an example of similar problems throughout Warrington.

Almost all routes from South Warrington into Warrington rely on 3 old/ poorly maintained swing bridges.

Are Warrington developing significantly more housing stock than they are required to to provide for the housing needs of Manchester and Liverpool?

The plan says that air quality is good in Warrington, which I just don't believe to be true. This is of great concern to me as family members with Asthma / COPD.

I am horrified that the green belt will be destroyed in our area when the news worldwide is about protecting our environment and trying to prevent climate change.

Has the rest of the infrastructure of Warrington ie. health services/ hospitals / leisure facilities been upgraded prior to this local plan? - absolutely NOT. I work at our local hospital which is not fit for purpose, unlike other local towns. Several local clinics have been closed ie Stockton Heath, Lymm and although they were not fit for purpose the local area haven't been provided with a replacement clinic. The leisure centre at Broomfields is an absolute disgrace.
