I am writing to object and voice my concerns at the proposed plans to build thousands of new homes on our green belt across Appleton, Grappenhall, Appleton Thorn and Stretton.

This plan to develop this area will destroy the landscape and character of our villages. It also poses more impact on our already poor transport infrastructure in particular a main issue of mine would be the already congested roads (A49 & A50) that lead towards the M6/M56 junction at Lymm services would be even worse making mine, my partners and everyone in the surrounding areas lives hell when using them trying to get to work. The plan doesn't take this into consideration and I feel It would be reckless to go ahead with it.
