Dear Council,

We are contacting you register our strong objections to the proposed building of homes on the Green Field land in Thelwall.

The very fact that this land has been designated Green Field should, frankly, indicate that it is not suitable for any such development which would destroy the character of the area. A Green Field site should remain just that. It was designated as such for a very good reason and those reasons have not changed.

This land is an important open space, giving the area a rural aspect that would vanish if the proposed development were to go ahead.
