In regards to the pland for Fiddlers Ferry site.

May I ask for horse access to be included on the recreational and parlands areas please.

The local horse riders have no safe off road riding routes.

The site is surrounded by at least 150 equines within 1 mile radious.

Although not all equines would use the site all at the same time it would be a huge benefit for the horse riding community if you would include them and change the pathways to multi user routes.
