My main concern being that the present infrastructure cannot cope with a 50%+ growth in residents. Middleton Lane and Delph Lane already struggle with traffic backing up, not only at rush hour, but also when there are home and local businesses deliveries.

- An increase in traffic from the proposed development could affect the safety of children and elderly local residents.
- The local schools are at capacity for local children, where would new families send the children?

 Culchelth Medical Centre, which covers the Winwick, Croft & the Culcheth area.
