I would like to object to the following aspects of the local plan that I do not think should go ahead at all:

1. Housing on Rushgreen Road, Lymm – this development will physically merge Lymm and Oughtrington together. It will adversely affect the pleasure of walking along the canal which is a popular walking route. This has already been damaged by the current house building occurring next to Sainsburys and the additional development will only make this worse.
2. Logistics site at Junction 20 of the M6 – this will triple the size of the existing sites, and together with all the extra housing at Appleton will overload the junction, and yet more warehouses in addition to Omega does not justify the permanent destruction of green belt land.
