I have recently been to see the revised Local Plans and have the following objections:

- 1. Loss of green belt land, whilst I agree with some areas of development are needed in the area and there are many options. I strongly object to the loss of green belt land. Keeping these areas of green will help to maintain the current character of the existing developments and villages as well as supporting local ecosystems.

Even if you can provide the structures where would the trained teachers, GP's and Dentists come from?

There is just not enough data and thought about the basics to warrant the proposed large development just yet. Solve the current problems before adding more.
