Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to object to the current Warrington Local Plan that has been published for consultation.

The plan is not sound as it will contradict the Council's position of supporting the Climate and Ecological Emergency Bill. The plan to build on greenbelt land and create commuter subjects without sufficient public transport will destroy the environment and create more pollution.

The plan is not sound because the development proposed is in locations that will promote car use and therefore create more congestion and pollution for south Warrington.

The plan is not sound because it neglects the opportunity and needs to regenerate central Warrington, instead choosing to expand into greenbelt and encourage residents to continue to travel to Manchester and Liverpool for work, shopping and leisure.

The plan is not sound as it does not seek to exploit or enhance the public transport infrastructure in Warrington. There is no consideration of using the existing rail system to create a freight or transport hub.

The plan is not sound because the number of houses planned is well above the number forecast in the 2018 ONS data predicts.

I strongly oppose these plans and request that you reconsider the current proposal.
