I deeply oppose the local plan for South East Warrington. My reasons are:

The pollution levels will increase significantly - some levels already exceed national standards, this will only get worse and is not an environment in which I want my young children to grow.

Light pollution and noise will replace fields, wildlife, trees and hedgerows. Today, we went for a walk in the countryside - we live in a beautiful area of the country - this would be ruined if this plan goes ahead. That is not an environment in which I want my young children to grow.

Proposed building height in parts is 43.5 m, taller than the Statue of Liberty and will be seen for miles around. This is outrageous, we live in small villages, not a city centre. There is no place for this size of building in our community.

Brownfield sites MUST be used before green belt is destroyed. The increase in road traffic will be enormous and given how gridlocked South Warrington already gets with any accidents on the motorways, the situation will only get worse. The level of pollution as a result will also significantly increase.

The planned development on Thelwall Heys is also outrageous. This is where we walked today and the thought of all this green belt being removed is scandalous and heartbreaking.

There is no justification for the volume of housing, the loss of green belt, the increased pollution and therefore harm to air quality, the loss of our beautiful local villages.

I STRONGLY OBJECT to all the proposals.
