To whom it may concern

I wish to oppose the plan drafted by the council to build more houses in south Warrington. I am extremely concerned about the following points:

- 1- the effects of carbon emissions on the environment if further housing is built as this will imply more cars
- 2- the impact on wildlife and green belt, more people suffer from mental health and the erosion of green spaces means less areas to walk and enjoy the outdoors which is a proven remedy for stress
