I am writing to express my opposition to the proposed building of over 300 houses on green belt land at Thelwall Heys. This area was designated as green belt in 2006 and these boundaries are supposed to endure. This land was not included in the 2017 or 2019 versions of the plan. Where will the access be to this site for building contractors vehicles and the resulting extra cars. The roads around here are already extremely busy and frequently completely blocked when there is an incident on one of the motorways. More traffic, more air pollution. The fields in this area are regularly flooded and this will only be made worse by building development. What provision has been made for extra health facilities, schools etc.

I am also strongly opposed to the Six56 employment area at the motorway junction. Again the loss of acres of greenbelt land and an increase in traffic both private cars and commercial and heavy goods vehicles in addition to the vast amount of traffic that already comes from the Appleton Thorn business/industrial estate. More traffic, more air pollution. Will there be anything left of England's green and pleasant land for future generations ?Not in our area if these proposals go ahead.
