Subject: 300 new homes on the green belt of Lymm

Dear Sir/Madam,

I recently became aware of a plan to build 300 new homes in the Lymm Green Belt.

At a time when traffic through the village is already at an all-time high, with public services like GP practices and schools already stretched to the limit, I struggle to see the logic behind this. Lymm's character comes from being a relatively small, quaint village, easily accessible from neighbouring cities like Warrington or Manchester. This draws in tourists, which undoubtedly bring benefit to the village helping sustain traditional commerce. I fear that the development of 300 new homes will simply accelerate the transformation of Lymm into a drab suburb of Warrington.

From an environmental point of view, such a development can only worsen the air quality as a result of increased traffic. Like so many other Cheshire villages, Lymm village centre is quickly becoming a throughway for traffic, especially during rush-hour.

I ask that you take these points into consideration when deliberating on the planning application.
