I do not believe the plan is sound as it will cause a significant increase in congestion across the area. The local roads in the south east urban extension are mainly narrow winding rural roads and not suited to the additional traffic from 4000 homes. Furthermore the existing bridges over the ship canal are not suitable for this level of additional traffic all funnelling through bridge foot roundabout will cause congestion, pollution and associated chaos for not just those of us living in south Warrington but also for those in central / north Warrington. I believe the original plan had a new high level canal crossing, without this you are going to cause more traffic problems.

Are additional services been implemented such as GP surgeries, nursery / school places, local food shops to avoid new homes having to get in their cars?
Sandy Lane recycling centre and Stockton Heath itself will not cope with additional traffic from this urban extension.

Please cease trying to build so many homes in unsuitable locations.
