I would like to register my objections to the above development as follows.

I have lived on [REDACTED] for 50 years; During this time I have seen the area grow and the traffic multiply putting demands on the nearest village for shopping, Stockton Heath. Traffic through the village is congested and queuing is inevitable. Parking is a constant problem and many of the side roads are difficult to drive down due to parked vehicles. I believe that building houses on green belt in Appleton and Appleton Thorn will mean a likely increase of a minimum of 2 additional cars per property exacerbating the congestion on the roads and village and adding greatly to pollution in these areas.

Also due to the need to cross 2 canals and 1 river, in order to get into Warrington from the south of the town, additional congestion will continue to increase with the number of houses built.

There is already a lack of facility in this area and I am concerned about the the increase in demand for schooling, doctors and dentists.

Finally I can not understand why the many brown sites available have not been selected for housing before the need to destroy green belt.

I believe that with the pressures of climate change we have an obligation to look after our environment and wildlife for future generations.
