Subject: Objection to the South East Urban Extension

Dear Sir/Madam.

My name is Ian Gribben of [REDACTED] I would like to object to the local plans for the following reasons.

- * The development of green belt land where other options are available.
- * The lack of prioritisation of non greenbelt options for initial development.
- * Lack of planning for infrastructure.
- * The removal of agricultural farming industry in a post brexit era where we should be supporting british produce.
- * The reduction of arable farming knowing the environmental impact of meat will increase arable demand in the future.
- * The reduction of habitats for local wildlife. E.g. woodpeckers, jays, buzzards and bats. All of which are seen in wrights green.
- * Approval of peel hall in North warrington means that the demand for extension in south warrington should be reduced. There is no accomodation for this in the current plan.
- * The lack of consideration for the conversion of un-needed office spaces given the national transition to working from home.
