Dear sir,

Please accept this email as my response in opposition to the proposed development and building as detailed in the Warrington Local Plan. I wish to cite the following reasons as to why I oppose the proposed developments:

- The number of new houses and their associated vehicles is unsustainable for the area.
- Existing roads and services are stretched as it is. The roads are very congested. Public transport is minimal in this area and the increased traffic and congestion is not acceptable on safety grounds and also for environmental pollution and air quality. Proposed improvements for road infrastructure and schools and medical services are inadequate.
- . There is no solution for the canal crossings.
- The development will destroy the Green Belt land. One of the reasons we moved to this area was because of the green spaces which support healthy physical and mental well-being. This will be lost if housing is allowed to be built.
- We can see the damage already done in Appleton Thorn village and the development of new houses there have destroyed the landscape and scenery of a once picturesque village.

We live in a beautiful part of Cheshire which is sought after, however increasing the number of dwellings will create an urbanisation as seen in other parts of Warrington which is not in keeping with the rest of the area and will no doubt have an impact environmentally and socially. I urge you to reconsider this plan.
