RE: My opposition to the proposed Warrington Local Plan

My concerns are noted below:

- Concern that this plan will place increased pressure on local services such as the education and health service. Many of the local schools are already a two-form entry, so I wonder where all the children from the development will be educated, then beyond primary school the impact it will have on the secondary schools, where will the extra funding come from?
- Concern for the road and traffic pressure the new homes will place. It does not take much for an accident on the motorway or surrounding local roads to cause heavy or grid locked traffic at certain times of the day. In addition to this the increase in poor air quality.
- Concern for an assumed high level of housing need and local growth, which seems to simply justify the release of the greenbelt land. In addition to this all the site traffic within the local area and following this those traveling in and out for work, as it would appear like other examples such as Amazon at Manchester Airport, these jobs are filled by those that travel in and out of the area. Placing an even greater strain on the local area.
- Grave concerns the removal and/or loss of local wildlife and green space. For the future of our young children and children yet to be born, we should be striving for a better and healthier Warrington for them to grow up in, protecting our environment for generations to come. And in given the recent movements in climate change and COP26, now is the ideal time to be proposing a 'green' plan as once the land has been lost, it is lost forever!

Therefore, I would like to see the plan rereviewed and changed.
