We spend hours litter picking on this lane. When I run around the local areas and roads it is already a problem on other surrounding country roads too. It also means many more people travelling in to the area from further away, this leads to an increase in public transport vehicles/routes, road congestion, crime and would completely ruin the integrity of the area.

There does not seem to be any positives for me as a resident of the area when reading over the proposed plans. It seems unjustified and unfair to expect to be able to increase the housing and people numbers so drastically. The area will be ruined in too many ways to mention, it would be such a shame as currently it is such a beautiful place with each town/village with a lovely sense of community and spectacular surrounding areas of unspoilt beauty. We need to fight to protect such areas.
