Subject: Objection to your Local Plan

I wish to object to your local plan on the following grounds -

- There are large pockets of brownfield sites which haven't yet been utilised which are suitable for meeting Warrington's housing needs. Green Belt should not be touch till this is exhausted;
- Your figures for the growth do not stack up and are inaccurate and misleading. It is wrong to base a plan on this;
