I am writing to strongly object to the shocking & ridiculous planning development proposal for South Warrington. I cannot believe the plan to build over 4000 houses has been issued:

\* Green belt should remain green belt, or you'll be destroying precious habitats & ecosystems, & killing wildlife. (I know the % of green belt to be used has been reduced, but this is irrelevant - it should be 0%.)

\* South Warrington infrastructure is particularly poor - we are reliant on cars (no train stations), & traffic is already a huge issue, especially at pinch points e.g. canal crossings. The proposed development will only worsen these problems, increasing pollution & harming health & the environment.

\* Government targets are no excuse - if it's not possible to use e.g. brownfield sites to avoid using green belt, the council should be pushing back.
