
## **Essential Roadworks**

## A57 Manchester Road Structural Maintenance Starting 30 September 2024 for up to 8 Weeks



Residents, Businesses and Motorists are advised that major road works to resurface A57 MANCHESTER ROAD, Woolston, from east of the junction at Redwood Close to east of the junction at Riversdale are programmed to commence on 30 September 2024 and will take up to 8 weeks to complete.

The road, and its side roads, will be closed between 7:00pm and 1:00am to undertake the works safely. All roads will be fully open to traffic outside these times.

The signed diversion route will be via Cockedge Green Roundabout, A49 Lythgoes Lane, A49 Winwick Road, A50 Long Lane, A50 Orford Green, Hilden Place, A50 Orford Road, A574 Birchwood Way, Woolston Grange Avenue and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times during the works. Vehicular access will be under the control of the contractor as directed on site.

Vehicles parked on the road or footway obstructing the works may be removed.

Information on bus services will be posted at stops prior to the commencement of the works.
