Notice of Application for the grant of a premises licence

- Recorded music - Monday to Thursday 12 – 23:30pm Friday and Saturday 12- 1:00am and Sunday 12-23:30pm
- Anything of a similar description to live and recorded music – Monday to Thursday 1800 – 23:00pm Friday 18:00 – 12:30 Saturday to Sunday 12:00 – 12:30am
